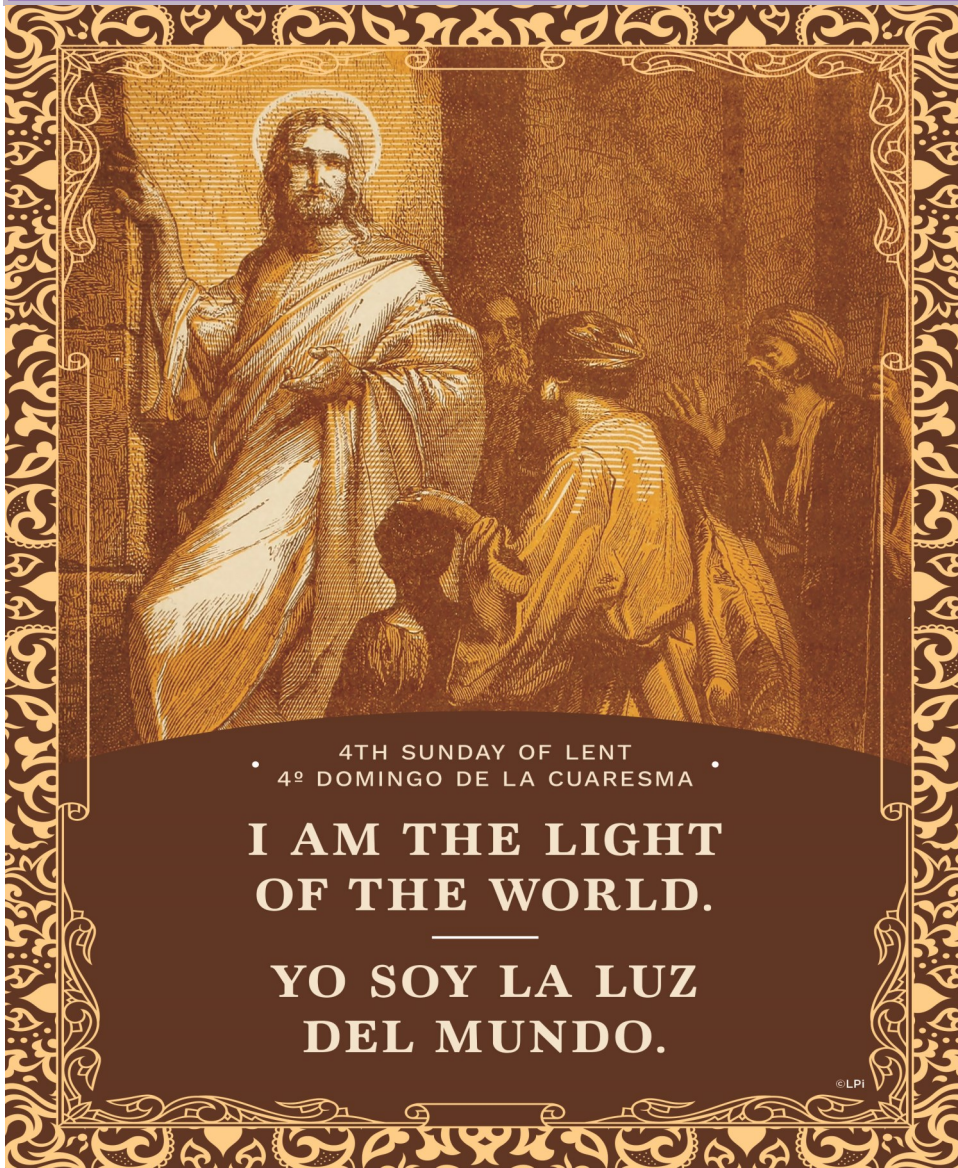

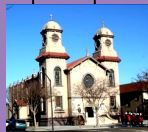

Lætare Sunday

This Sunday is traditionally called *Lætare* Sunday. The mournful and penitential character of Lent is slightly interrupted. Today's chants speak of joy and consolation. In olden times the organ was silent for the past three weeks, but on this day the organ is played again. The liturgical color changes from purple to rose.

Starting from the fourth century, there was a Lenten tradition in Rome, where the faithful would gather on designated churches (known as the "station churches") to celebrate the Holy Eucharist either with the Holy Father or with his delegate. It emphasized the unity of the Christian community of Rome during penitential seasons.

For *Lætare* Sunday, the Station was the Basilica of the Holy Cross (Basilica di Santa Croce in Gerusalemme). It was built in the fourth century, by the emperor Constantine. Saint Helen had a great quantity of earth from Mount Calvary brought in. Her intention was to make it the 'Jerusalem of Rome'; so the name. She enriched it with the instruments of the Passion: we have here the fragment of the true Cross, the inscription of the Cross, a thorn from the Crown of Thorns, one of the three Nails, part of the cross of the Good Thief, and the finger of Saint Thomas.

Up to the fourteenth century, the ceremony of the golden rose took place in this church. The blessing of the golden rose is one of the ceremonies peculiar to the Fourth Sunday of Lent. The rose is symbolic also of the spring of Easter that is awaiting us. The prayer of blessing the rose highlights this anticipated joy of Easter. If the penitential practice of Lent weighs us down, *Lætare Sunday gives us great encouragement for the days ahead. We are reminded today that Lent is not a season of sadness, rather a time of joy because during this season we walk side-by-side with Jesus – carrying our daily crosses.*

Domingo de Lætare

Este domingo se llama tradicionalmente Domingo de Lætare. El carácter lúgubre y penitencial de la Cuaresma se interrumpe ligeramente. Los cantos de hoy hablan de alegría y consuelo. Antiguamente, el órgano permanecía en silencio durante las últimas tres semanas, pero este día se vuelve a tocar. El color litúrgico cambia de morado a rosa.

Desde el siglo IV, existía en Roma una tradición cuaresmal: los fieles se reunían en iglesias designadas (conocidas como "iglesias de la estación") para celebrar la Sagrada Eucaristía con el Santo Padre o con su delegado. Esta tradición enfatizaba la unidad de la comunidad cristiana de Roma durante los tiempos penitenciales.

Para el Domingo de Lætare, la Estación era la Basílica de la Santa Cruz (Basilica di Santa Croce in Gerusalemme). Fue construida en el siglo IV por el emperador Constantino. Santa Elena mandó traer una gran cantidad de tierra del Monte Calvario. Su intención era convertirla en la "Jerusalén de Roma"; de ahí su nombre. La enriqueció con los instrumentos de la Pasión: tenemos aquí el fragmento de la verdadera Cruz, la inscripción de la Cruz, una espina de la Corona de Espinas, uno de los tres Clavos, parte de la cruz del Buen Ladrón y el dedo de Santo Tomás.

Hasta el siglo XIV, la ceremonia de la rosa de oro se celebraba en esta iglesia. La bendición de la rosa de oro es una de las ceremonias propias del Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma. La rosa simboliza también la primavera de la Pascua que nos espera. La oración de bendición de la rosa resalta esta alegría anticipada de la Pascua. Si la práctica penitencial de la Cuaresma nos agobia, el Domingo de Lætare nos infunde un gran aliento para los días venideros. Hoy recordamos que la Cuaresma no es un tiempo de tristeza, sino de alegría, porque durante este tiempo caminamos junto a Jesús, cargando con nuestras cruces diarias.

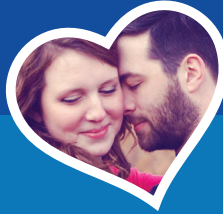
